Dock Fee (Receiving & Delivery) \$5.00 per item (\$ 30-dollar minimum charge)
Open and Limited Inspect for Concealed Damage (includes photos)\$12.50 <i>Per parcel when requested / Automatic if packaging is damaged</i>
Rug Inspection A repackaging and inspection fee will be applied for Rugs inspections\$20.00(re)-Packing material 120 gauge shrink wrap\$10.00
Storage Fee
For the first five items and then \$ 12.50 Per item/per week held at our warehouse.
(Oversized item fee: Any item with larger that displaces more than 26 Sq. Ft. of floor spaceper week \$12.50)

Debris Removal

Removal of packaging debris \$5.00 per item (\$ 30-dollar minimum charge). For non-recyclable items an additional dump fees may apply

Failed Inspections

Items which fail the inspection process will be subject to Damaged goods handling fee (\$25 per item. Storage Fees will apply until removed from the warehouse. If the common carrier swaps item, the dock fee will be waived on the outgoing item.

Inspections are limited to critical or major manufacturer's defects and shipping related damage. We do not check for discolorations, warping, visual imperfections, mistakes in textiles or compliance to advertised aesthetics. Inspections may not remove protective padding (foam, biodegradable padding, bubble wrap, or padded dividers) and therefore cannot inspect sections of the furniture covered by these items.
